3. Main Characteristics of job conditions

Housekeeping requires, according to Valentina, a lot of expertise. But she has told us several times that nobody ever taught her about it. She is not particularly interested in being trained, so as to rise her abilities. She has become expert by practice, experiencing different methods at various times.

She uses (small) appliances for carrying out household. The most used are the washing machine, though she says she prefers to wash by hand some clothing; the oven to cook; the hand-held mixer; the dishwasher, she uses daily, though sometimes she likes to do the washing up by hand; the vacuum cleaner for the floors, used every day too.

She tells us to realize how different is her housekeeping now in comparison with the time when, although carrying out household, she was working out of home. Now she does work more calmly with less stress and is more tolerant of the mess left around by her husband and daughters. The most noticeable difference with the past is that before, when she was doing the shopping once a week, she used to buy products in large amount, and had to throw away part of them, those not consumed; on the contrary now that she does the shopping more times during the week, she succeeds in buying only what she really needs, reducing that way waste and saving money.

The whole family recycles garbage in a field near to their house, where there is the compost for organic waste. Despite her role as a housekeeper, she is involved in many interests, in which theater, that she carries on together with other engagements and her family duties, and training courses to become a professional woman as a future work. She is trying to go back to the world of work, due to various opportunities she came across. She surfs the internet, the social network and other new technologies of communication both for playing and for finding new methods of doing homework and new food recipes.

During the two hours of observation in her house, we saw Valentina preparing lunch for the family. From our interview we also discovered other qualities related to her charges and skills in managing family life. Definitely she shows a great capacity to plan the medical visits and treatments of each of the members of the family, due also to her previous work experience. She also keeps herself up to date for the news of the school of her daughters, not helping them in their homework, unless required. Good practice because her daughters are very independent and are rather successful at school.

She declares to use personal methods for household chores, to minimize the time spent, according to her experience she had done when she was living alone. Very interested also in "alternative" methods giving her the possibility to reach the result with less environmental impact. For example, she renounced to the softener, in favor of vinegar and essential oils to perfume linen. She is aware of being a good cook, first dishes(especially baked pasta) and cakes (her younger daughter confirms); within the various duties of a housekeeper she doesn't dislike to iron. - Preparing meals;
- Experience in negotiation;
- Handling school-family relationships;
- Looking after the social relationships of the members of the family;
